2019 Orlando Trip Chaperone Commitment Form

We will travel to Walt Disney World in Orlando, FL to perform in a parade on Friday, March 22, 2019. Dates of travel will be Wednesday, March 20 through Sunday, March 24. The highlight of the trip involves The Marching Pioneers participating in a parade through a park at Walt Disney World.

Chaperones agree that they will report to assigned destinations on-time for meal ticket distribution, entering and leaving the parks, and meeting the buses at the designated times. Students are given the opportunity to walk the parks in small groups, without their chaperones; therefore, we ask that you share contact information with your group as well as have their information. Should the students not arrive at the designated times, that student(s) will forfeit their right to go on their own and will follow the chaperone for the remainder of that day. Also, we ask that each chaperone wear the Patriot Band shirt that has been selected for the day or Patriot spirit wear. There will be times set for the groups to visit each of the parks; therefore, please do not leave any park for another park on your own.

We are **not allowed** to provide any student with **medication** (even for a headache) if that student has not provided their own medication and **filed the proper documentation**. As a reminder, there are First Aid stations in the parks that students may visit if needed.

While at the hotel, chaperones will monitor the hallways throughout the evening. Each chaperone will choose a shift in which they will stay in the hallway – each shift will have two (2) chaperones. Chaperones will check each of the students assigned to them immediately prior to lights out and ensure their students know their wake up / breakfast times.

Payment for the Spring trip will be split into 3 payments. Payments of \$300 should be made by October and November with the final payment in January. We will determine the final payment amount once the amount of student participation is known and final payment calculations are defined. You may make payments separate from this schedule; however, the amount per scheduled payment must be met. If payments are not met, a seat may be given to another person at a risk of no refund for the amount already paid. After November, refunds will not be available should you have to cancel or have a change of mind. Please speak to a member of the Board if you need assistance in any way. It is truly our goal to allow all persons to participate!

Parents of participating students are placing a significant amount of trust in our chaperones to help guide, monitor and assist their children. Understand that no alcoholic beverages are to be consumed by any chaperones at any time during the trip. Also, no smoking will be allowed either. Please remember, the first priority of the chaperones is to be there for the students. Thank you again for chaperoning, as it is your support that helps make this trip possible – we look forward to a fun and safe time with the Marching Pioneers in Florida!!
