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2019 Orlando Trip Student Commitment Form

The Patriot Marching Pioneers will travel to Walt Disney World in Orlando, FL to perform in a parade on Friday, March 22, 2019. Dates of travel will be Wednesday, March 20 through Sunday, March 24. The highlight of the trip involves The Marching Pioneers participating in a parade through a park at Walt Disney, park to be determined. The Marching Pioneers will also be spending on of the days at Universal Studios.

Each student will be assigned a chaperone and are asked to share their contact information with that chaperone. Students agree that they will report to assigned destinations on-time for meal ticket distribution, entering and leaving the parks, meeting the buses and other designated times. Should a student not return to the designated times or locations, that student will remain with their chaperone for the remainder of that day. Also, we require that students wear the Patriot Band shirt that has been selected for each day. While there is a transportation system between parks, students are not to jump from park-to-park unless they have consent to do so.

While at the hotel, students agree to stay on the floor that has been assigned to them and will not enter the room of any other students, unless given approval by a chaperone to do so.

Students will not take any medication unless the proper PWCS documentation and procedure is being followed. All medication will be held by the chaperone(s) tasked with organizing student medications. Even over-the-counter medicines (such as Aspirin) must be given by the chaperone. It is against PWCS regulations to self-medicate.

Payment for the Spring trip will be split into 3 payments. Payments of \$300 should be made by October and November 2018 with the final payment in January 2019. We will determine the final payment amount once the amount of student participation is known and final payment calculations are defined. You may make payments separate from this schedule; however, the amount per scheduled payment must be met. If payments are not met, a seat may be given to another person at a risk of no refund for the amount already paid. After November, refunds will not be available should you have to cancel or have a change of mind. *Also, remember that all money collected for the trip will first be put towards marching band dues and other fees, if such are outstanding.* Please speak to a member of the Board if you need assistance in any way. It is truly our goal to allow all persons to participate!
